Slips and Trips	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ Advise to wear appropriate footwear.</li> <li>+ Advise that ground may be slippery.</li> <li>+ Be aware of tree roots</li> </ul>	
Wet Weather	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ Everyone to be advised to bring coats.</li> <li>+ Groups have the option to put up shelters.</li> <li>+ HI VIS jackets to be worn</li> </ul>	
Geese and other Animals	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ Do not feed or touch any animals</li> <li>+ Avoid running at them</li> <li>+ Wash hands after any contact if it cannot be helped</li> <li>+ Watch out for poo</li> </ul>	
Steep Hills	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ No running</li> </ul>	
People be run over/hit	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ Traffic to keep to site speed limit of 5mph. Traffic controllers to wear high vis at all time.</li> </ul>	
Cars crashing	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>+ Traffic controllers to wear high vis at all time. Traffic controllers to carry radios at all times.</li> </ul>

Low visibility	All	+ Traffic controllers to wear high vis at all time. Traffic control wands to be used if required.	
Pedestrians	All	+ Pedestrians to be directed out of the parking area.	
Car Jam	All	+ One way system to be used and adhered to.
